

Construction: March to Nov 2012




March – November

- Southbound on-ramp to US 41 CLOSED
- Access to US 41 from Ashland Ave maintained

September 17 – November

- Interchange and Main Ave CLOSED for a maximum of 60 days
- Mid Valley Dr at Main Ave CLOSED
- Lawrence Dr park & ride lot CLOSED

Construction: March to Nov 2012



September 17 – November

- Ashland Ave median at Parkview Rd CLOSED during the reconstruction of the Main Avenue interchange

Main Avenue interchange alternate routes

- WIS 32 to Ashland Ave ramp to US 41 south access ramp
- WIS 32 to WIS 172 is the primary access to the north
- All other county highway roads are open to movement
