MEETING PURPOSE

The primary purpose of this meeting is to provide businesses with firsthand information regarding construction activities at the Main Avenue interchange. This meeting will provide updates on:

- Construction schedule for the full closure of the Main Avenue interchange
- Alternate route options when the Main Avenue interchange is closed

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will also provide information about business signing opportunities that will connect customers with area businesses during construction (details on pg. 3).

MEETING FORMAT

Today's Business Group Meeting will run from 7:30 to 9 a.m. with a short presentation at 7:45 a.m. Construction staging exhibits and alternate route displays are available for viewing and project staff are on hand for questions.

MAIN AVENUE INTERCHANGE

September 17 - November


- Interchange and Main Avenue CLOSED for 60 consecutive days
- Mid Valley Drive at Main Avenue CLOSED except for local access
- Ashland Avenue median at Parkview Road CLOSED
- Lawrence Drive park and ride lot CLOSED for reconstruction



CONSTRUCTION TIMELINES

Construction at the Main Avenue interchange began in early March and will continue through November. The entire interchange including Main Avenue beneath US 41 is scheduled to be CLOSED for a maximum of 60 consecutive days beginning September 17, 2012.

Reconstruction of US 41 mainline from Orange Lane to Glory Road is included with the Main Avenue interchange project. This segment of US 41 mainline began in March 2012 and will be completed by June 2013.




LEGEND

ALTERNATE ROUTES DURING CONSTRUCTION

Alternate routes have been identified to assist the public and businesses during the reconstruction of the Main Avenue interchange.

- WIS 32 to Ashland Avenue ramp to US 41 south access ramp
- WIS 32 to WIS 172 is the primary access to the north
- All other county highway roads are open to movement



HIGHWAY BUSINESS SIGNAGE DURING CONSTRUCTION

Local businesses have the opportunity to develop temporary directional signage to direct customers to their business during construction. The temporary directional signs are typically located in the highway right of way along exit-ramps near the project, endpoints of the construction project, or detour and side roads approaching the project.
