

# US 41 Project: Noise Barriers

At the start of the US 41 Project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) determined noise impacts and evaluated possible mitigation measures, such as noise barriers. After careful evaluation, WisDOT is planning to install noise barriers to minimize noise impacts along segments of the US 41 mainline.

Noise barriers will be constructed along segments of US 41 between the WIS 172 and Mason Street interchanges as shown on the map to the right.


