US 41 lane restrictions the week of March 15 in Oshkosh

Expect rolling road block this evening

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is announcing various overnight lane closures are planned on US 41 in Oshkosh this week. Northbound and southbound traffic lanes will have restrictions in the area of the future 20th Avenue and Witzel Avenue overpasses in Oshkosh.

Monday, March 15, the left (passing) lane of US 41 northbound between WIS 44 and WIS 21 is scheduled to be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday, March 16. A rolling road block is also planned for March 15 from 9:30 p.m. to 10 p.m. impacting both lanes of US 41 southbound between US 45 and 9th Avenue.

Overnight closures are also scheduled for Wednesday, March 17 and Thursday, March 18 involving the left (passing) lane of US 41 northbound between 9th Avenue and WIS 21, and the left (passing) lane of US 41 southbound between 9th Avenue and WIS 44. The lane closures and rolling road block are needed to move equipment and materials into the median for the construction of the future 20th Avenue and Witzel Avenue overpasses.

Motorists are reminded to remain alert when driving through any work zone.
