Lane closures on US 41 at WIS 76, Snell Road & Lake Butte des Morts

Winnebago County traffic impacts for the week of June 7

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region Office in Green Bay is announcing lane restrictions for the week of June 7 on US 41 in the Oshkosh area. Motorists can expect closures in northbound and southbound lanes near the WIS 76 interchange, Snell Road overpass, and future Lake Butte des Morts Drive overpass. All lane closures will take place during overnight hours.

Monday, June 7 through Tuesday, June 8:

- Right lanes of US 41 northbound and southbound near the WIS 76 interchange closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for the reconstruction of the ramps connecting US 41 to WIS 76. Speed limits in the area reduced to 55 miles per hour.

Monday, June 7 through Thursday, June 10:

- Various lanes of US 41 northbound and southbound near the new Snell Road overpass closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. so construction crews can stain overpass. Expect rolling roadblocks each night stopping traffic for up to 5 minutes.

Monday, June 7 through Tuesday, June 8:

- Right lane of US 41 northbound and southbound between US 45 and WIS 21 closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to allow for girder placement at the future Lake Butte des Morts Drive overpass. Rolling roadblocks scheduled each night stopping traffic for up to 20 minutes.

All closures are weather dependant and subject to change. Motorists should to use caution and remain alert when driving in this or any work zone.
