

Temporary traffic switch at WIS 172 interchange in Brown County

Southbound US 41 entrance ramp from westbound WIS 172 changed

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing a temporary traffic switch for westbound WIS 172 motorists wanting to enter southbound US 41. Beginning overnight Thursday, October 17, westbound traffic seeking southbound US 41 will continue on WIS 172, pass under US 41 and use a temporary ramp to access US 41 southbound. See map below:



Traffic will stay in this pattern for the next three months. The switch is needed to complete work on the US 41 Project. Motorists are reminded to remain alert and use caution when traveling through this or any work zone.

All lane restrictions are weather dependent and subject to change.
