TONIGHT: Several overnight ramp closures in Brown County

Ramp closures between Mason Street and Velp Avenue

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing several US 41 on and off-ramp closures between Mason Street and Velp Avenue tonight, Thursday, August 22. The closures are due to weather preventing overnight construction yesterday. The ramp closures are:

- **Northbound US 41 on-ramp from Mason Street** will be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
 - Drivers can use Lombardi Avenue to access northbound US 41.

- **Northbound US 41 off-ramp to WIS 29** will also be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. The following detour will be in place:
 - **Eastbound WIS 29** traffic will take Mason Street east to Military Avenue and follow Military Avenue north to eastbound WIS 29
 - **Westbound WIS 29** traffic will take Mason Street west to Packerland Drive and follow Packerland Drive north to westbound WIS 29

- **Southbound US 41 on-ramp from WIS 29** will be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. The following detour will be in place:
 - **Eastbound and westbound WIS 29** traffic seeking US 41 will take Packerland Avenue south to Mason Street and follow Mason Street east to US 41

- **Northbound US 41 on-ramp from WIS 29** will be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. The following detour will be in place:
 - **Eastbound and westbound WIS 29** traffic seeking US 41 will take Military Avenue north to Velp Avenue and follow Velp Avenue west to US 41

- **Northbound US 41 off-ramp to Velp Avenue** will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - Drivers can access Velp Avenue via the Lineville Road interchange

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
