Meeting scheduled for WIS 441/Little Lake Butte des Morts bridge

WisDOT discusses new design plans and next steps

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office is announcing a public information meeting to provide an update on the WIS 441 Tri-County Construction Project. The meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, June 25, 2013 from 5 to 7 p.m. at the Butte des Morts Elementary School Commons, 501 Tayco Street, Menasha. There will be a short presentation at 5:15 pm and the remainder of the meeting will follow an open house format. WisDOT staff and engineers will be on hand to answer questions.

The purpose of the meeting is to:

- Continue communication between WisDOT and the local communities and businesses
- Provide an overview of the latest project design plans and schedule
- Provide firsthand information about project milestones and next steps

The WIS 441 Tri-County Project will reconstruct and expand US 10/WIS 441 from four to six lanes from Cold Spring Road to about 1/2 mile east of Oneida Street (approximately six miles). The project is needed to address safety concerns and traffic demands. Additional lanes of traffic are needed on US 10/WIS 441 to handle expected traffic increases safely in the years ahead.

Project improvements include:

- New US 41 Interchange
- New Little Lake Butte des Morts bridge
- Improved WIS 441 interchanges at:
 - County P (Racine Road)
 - WIS 47 (Appleton Road)

- County AP (Midway Road)
- US 10 (Oneida Street)
