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Paving continues on Leo Frigo Bridge in Brown County

Weight and lane restrictions on northbound and southbound lanes

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing that paving will continue on the Leo Frigo Bridge, Thursday, May 9 and Friday, May 10. During this time, weight restrictions will be in place. Maximum gross weight is 40 tons for northbound and southbound traffic. WI State Patrol will be on site to enforce the weight restriction.

Traffic on I-43 at the Leo Frigo Memorial Bridge will continue to be reduced to a single lane of traffic with speeds reduced to 55 mph on I-43 southbound over a 3.5-mile segment of the highway. Drivers should be aware of construction vehicles entering and exiting the workzone and expect significant travel delays.

All lane restrictions are weather dependent and subject to change.
