Weight restrictions on Leo Frigo Bridge in Brown County

Restrictions and rolling roadblocks for Thursday night

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing maintenance work on the Leo Frigo Bridge, Thursday, June 27 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. During bridge maintenance, weight restrictions will be in place. The maximum gross weight is 40 tons.

Traffic on I-43 at the Leo Frigo Memorial Bridge will continue to be reduced to a single lane with speeds reduced to 55 mph in both directions over a 3.5-mile segment of the highway. At various times, law enforcement will clear all traffic on northbound and southbound I-43 traffic using rolling roadblocks that will delay travelers for up to 15 minutes. Expect travel delays.

All lane restrictions are weather dependent and subject to change.
