Portion of US 41 to close in Winnebago County

Crews to demolish bridge deck on County G overpass

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing a full closure of northbound US 41 between WIS 76 and Breezewood Lane and a full closure of southbound US 41 between County II and WIS 76 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Tuesday, July 23, Wednesday, July 24 and Thursday July 25. The closures are needed so crews can demolish the bridge deck on the County G overpass.

Traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Northbound US 41 traffic will be detoured off at WIS 76; WIS 76 north to County II and follow County II to northbound US 41
- Southbound US 41 traffic will be detoured off at County II; County II west to WIS 76 and follow WIS 76 south to US 41

In addition, drivers can anticipate several ramp closures associated with the deck demolition:

- **Tuesday, July 23, Wednesday, July 24 and Thursday July 25:** The northbound US 41 on-ramp from WIS 76 and the southbound US 41 on-ramps from County II, County JJ and Breezewood Lane will all be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. in conjunction with the US 41 northbound full closure.

The re-decking and painting on the County G bridge is part of construction of three bridges in Winnebago County. Work also includes replacement of the County GG and County Y overpass when the County G work is complete. The bridges are also being widened to accommodate a multi-use trail

All lane restrictions are weather dependent and subject to change.
