

US 41 Project overview

- Largest construction project in the history of Northeast Wisconsin
 - Add new lanes to 31 miles of freeway in Winnebago and Brown Counties
 - Improve 16 interchanges (13 will be completely rebuilt)
 - Construct up to 44 roundabouts
 - Add traffic cameras and dynamic message signs
 - Improve lighting
 - Provide pedestrian and bicycle amenities

US 41 Project overview

- Brown County
 - Limits: Orange Lane to County M
 - Length: 14 miles
 - Construction: 2010 – 2017
 - Budget: \$1.005 billion




US 41 Mega Project goals

Resort Road Mitigation Site

Project Purpose

- Mitigate wetland impacts for US 41 corridor expansion in Brown County
- Increase pike spawning opportunity within the site




Mitigation Site Project History

- Recognized that US 41 expansion wetland impacts would require mitigation
- Agreement between DNR, WisDOT, and Village of Suamico for use of Resort Road property
- Ongoing coordination between WisDOT, DNR, and Army Corps of Engineers, and Brown County Conservation

Project Highlights

- Excavate 440,000 cubic yards of material to create wetland areas
- Lengthen the existing water channels to increase pike spawning opportunity
- Construct water control structures along drainage channels
- Install a new culvert pipe crossing resort road




Traffic and Roadway Impacts

- Increased truck traffic accessing County J and across Resort Road due to hauling of excavated material
 - Use of flaggers is anticipated
 - The contractor will be expected to keep haul roads clear of debris
 - Hauling along Resort Road will not be allowed
- Culvert Pipe Installation across Resort Road will require lane closures
 - Access along Resort Road will be maintained.
 - Resort Rd will fully re-open by the end of the day

Anticipated Haul Routes

- Wasted material moved off site
- Most Likely Route
 - County J south to County B
 - County B west to US 41
 - South on US 41
- Hauling of material along Resort Road will not be allowed



Project Schedule

- May 2011: Project letting
- June/July 2011: Begin construction
- July-October 2011: Site excavation, hauling, and seeding
- April/May 2012: Tree planting and final seeding
- Site monitoring through 2021
