### **Overnight, full closures of US 41 in Outagamie and Winnebago Counties Monday and Wednesday next week**

*Crews installing electronic message signs at two intersections*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing southbound US 41 at WIS 125/College Avenue intersection will close to traffic overnight Monday, Feb. 9, and northbound US 41 at the WIS 114/Winneconne Avenue intersection will close overnight Wednesday, Feb. 11. The full closures are needed for installation of messaging signs at the intersections.

Closure and detour information is as follows:

- **Full closure: Southbound US 41** at the WIS 125/College Avenue interchange, overnight Monday, Feb. 9 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. The interchange ramps will remain open.
  - Southbound US 41 traffic will be detoured onto the WIS 125/College Avenue interchange on and off-ramps to rejoin US 41.
- **Full closure: Northbound US 41** at WIS 114/Winneconne Avenue interchange, overnight Wednesday, Feb. 11, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. During the closure, the northbound 41 on-ramp from WIS 114/Winneconne Avenue and the northbound US 41 off-ramp to Main Street/Oakridge Road will also be closed.
  - Northbound US 41 traffic will be detoured off at WIS 114 and east to Green Bay Road, take Green Bay Road north to County II west to northbound US 41.

**All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.**
