Meeting purpose

The primary purpose of these meetings is to provide updated information to the business community, local officials and the general public about construction staging and schedules for the Oneida Street interchange area and the US 41 mainline from Glory Road to 9th Street.

These meetings will provide updates about:

- Upcoming 10-day CLOSURE of the northbound US 41 off-ramp to Oneida Street (begins mid-October 2014)
 - » Temporary signing opportunities for businesses during construction
- Latest construction schedule and upcoming traffic impacts
- Planned noise barriers along the US 41 mainline


Construction at the Oneida Street interchange and along the US 41 mainline

Major construction will continue along the US 41 mainline from Glory Road to 9th Street through the summer of 2016. In the near term, construction at the Oneida Street interchange includes a 10-day CLOSURE of the northbound US 41 off-ramp to Oneida Street beginning in mid-October 2014. Major construction will be completed at the Oneida Street interchange by the summer of 2016.
