## **Construction update meeting slated for businesses near the WIS 441 and Appleton Road interchange in Winnebago County**

*75-day closure, detour route and business signing to be discussed*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing a pre-closure, construction update meeting for businesses affected by the upcoming WIS 441/Appleton Road interchange reconstruction.

**Business Meeting:**

- Tuesday, March 17, from 7:30-9 a.m. at the WIS 441 Tri-County Construction Project Office, W6214 Aerotech Dr, Appleton. A brief presentation will begin at 7:45 a.m.

The meeting will provide businesses with information on:

- Upcoming 75-day closure of Appleton Road between Midway Road and the US 10/WIS 441 ramps
- Temporary signing opportunities and other resources for businesses
- Detour route during the closures: WIS 47 to County P (Valley Road/Racine Road); to County AP (Midway Road)

The Appleton Road interchange reconstruction is part of the WIS 441 Tri-County Project. WisDOT staff will be available to discuss the project on an individual basis.
