WIS 441 Tri-County Project lane closures for October 6 – October 10

Traffic restrictions on WIS 441 and US 10

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing WIS 441 Project lane restrictions for October 6 through October 10 in Winnebago, Outagamie and Calumet counties. Drivers should be aware of reduced speed limits and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone. This does not include closures by local authorities for accidents or unusual incidents (such as weather).

US 10/WIS 441 Roland Kampo Bridge

Drivers can anticipate lane restrictions, lane closings and narrow lanes on the WIS 441/US 10 Roland Kampo Bridge throughout the week as crews continue on-bridge construction of a second, parallel bridge over Little Lake Butte des Morts in Winnebago County. WisDOT asks drivers to remain alert and obey speed limits on the bridge at all times.

On-bridge traffic impacts include:

- Westbound US 10/WIS 441 between County P/Racine Street and US 41 will have overnight single lane closures **Monday through Thursday**, 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. and **Friday** 8 p.m. to 10 a.m.
- Eastbound US 10/WIS 441 between County P/Racine Street and US 41 will have a **FULL CLOSURE Tuesday through Thursday**, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. and **Friday** 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Detour as follows:

- Eastbound US 10 motorists take southbound US 41 to County Road II exit then access northbound US 41; Continue to the north junction of the US 41/WIS 441 system-to- system interchange in Outagamie County, then south on WIS 441 to eastbound US 10

US 41/WIS 441/US 10 system interchange

The following ramps will also be closed:

- Westbound US 10 to southbound US 41 ramp will be closed **NIGHTLY, Monday through Friday**, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Suggested alternate route:
 - Drivers can continue westbound US 10 to County CB, take County CB south to eastbound US 10 to southbound US 41
 - Drivers can also continue on westbound US 10 to County CB, take County CB south to County II/Winchester Road, follow County II/Winchester Road east to southbound US 41

- Southbound US 41 to eastbound US 10 ramp will be closed on **NIGHTLY, Monday through Friday**, from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Suggested alternate route:
 - Drivers can exit at westbound US 10 to County CB, take County CB south to eastbound US 10

- Southbound US 41 to westbound US 10 ramp will be closed **NIGHTLY, Tuesday through Thursday** from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Suggested alternate route:
 - Drivers can continue on US 41 and exit at County II, take County II west to County CB and go north to westbound US 10

- Northbound US 41 to eastbound US 10 ramp will be closed **NIGHTLY, Tuesday through Thursday** from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and on **Friday** from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Detour as follows:
 - Drivers can continue on US 41 for approximately 12 miles to southbound WIS 441, take southbound WIS 441 for 6 miles to US 10

US 10

There will be single lane closures on eastbound US 10 between County CB and southbound US 41 on-ramp beginning 6 a.m., Tuesday, October 7 through 10 a.m., Saturday, October 11.

US 41

There will also be nightly lane closures on southbound US 41 between County BB/Prospect Road and Jacobson Road **NIGHTLY, Monday through Friday**, from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
