WIS 441 Tri-County Project lane closures for January 5 – January 9

Traffic restrictions on WIS 441 and US 10

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing WIS 441 Project lane restrictions for January 5 through January 9 in Winnebago, Outagamie and Calumet counties. Drivers should be aware of reduced speed limits and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone. This does not include closures by local authorities for accidents or unusual incidents (such as weather).

US 41

Drivers may encounter daytime single lane closures on northbound and southbound US 41 between WIS 96/Wisconsin Avenue and WIS 114/County II.

Local Roads

Utility work at the intersection of WIS 47/Appleton Road/Valley Road began on Wednesday, Dec. 3 in Winnebago County and is expected to last into January 2015. The work is in preparation for next year's construction at WIS 47 (Appleton Road) interchange, a part of the WIS 441 Tri-County Expansion Project.

Traffic impacts for AT & T's utility construction include:

- A number of through lanes will be restricted during various stages
- Left-turns at Appleton Road and Valley Road will be prohibited during various stages
- Westbound Valley Road will be closed to motorists approaching the Appleton Road/Valley Road intersection during various stages

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
