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WIS 441 Tri-County Project lane closures for May 4 – May 8

Traffic restrictions on WIS 441 and US 10

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing WIS 441 Project lane restrictions for May 4 through May 8 in Winnebago, Outagamie and Calumet counties. Drivers should be aware of reduced speed limits and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone. This does not include closures by local authorities for accidents or unusual incidents (such as weather).

I-41 Bridge Maintenance Project

The following ramps will be closed for ten days and expected to open by May 14:

- Southbound I-41 on-ramp from College Avenue will be closed for ten days beginning on Monday, May 4
- Northbound I-41 off-ramp to College Avenue will be closed for ten days beginning on Monday, May 4

Traffic impacts will be significant, since the average daily traffic count for the northbound ramp is 7,400 vehicles and southbound is 5,600 vehicles. Motorists will need to find alternate routes and adjust their travel schedules.

Drivers should continue to expect portions of I-41 between Breezewood Lane/Bell Street in Winnebago County to WIS 15 in Outagamie County to be restricted to two lanes in each direction until late July. Note: This project is separate from WIS 441 Tri-County Project, but will be included on the WIS 441 road closure list.

System interchange

The following ramp will be closed:

- Westbound US 10/southbound WIS 441 to southbound I-41 ramp will be closed **NIGHTLY, Monday through Friday** from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Suggested alternate route:
 - Traffic seeking southbound I-41 should continue on westbound 10 to County CB, take County CB south to eastbound US 10, follow US 10 to southbound 1-41

Drum Corps Drive

Beginning on Friday, May 1 the intersection of Drum Corps Drive and Appleton Road will be closed to traffic. The intersection will re-open on Saturday, May 2 between the hours of 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. After 2:30 p.m., the intersection will remain closed until 7 a.m., Saturday, May 9. Pedestrian access will be maintained along the work zone.

Long-term closures

- 60-day closure of Cold Spring Road under US 10 (between Friendship Trail and American Drive), began on Monday, April 13.
- 75-day closure of WIS 441 / Appleton Road interchange ramps and a portion of Appleton Road (WIS 47) began on Monday, April 13.

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
