WIS 441 Tri-County Project lane closures for September 21 – September 26
Traffic restrictions on WIS 441 and US 10

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing WIS 441 Project lane restrictions for September 21 – September 26 in Winnebago, Outagamie and Calumet counties. Drivers should be aware of reduced speed limits and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone. This does not include closures by local authorities for accidents or unusual incidents (such as weather).

US 41

The following ramp will be closed:

- Westbound US 10 to southbound US 41 ramp will be closed **NIGHTLY** on **Sunday through Friday** from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Suggested alternate route:
 - Drivers should continue on westbound US 10 and exit at County CB, take County CB south to eastbound US 10/WIS 441, follow ramp to southbound US 41

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
