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### **Full-lane closures on US 41 in Oshkosh week of March 29**

*Crews begin setting bridge girders for 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue overpass*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is announcing that segments of US 41 between 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue and WIS 44 in Oshkosh are scheduled to close for three nights beginning March 29, as crews place girders for the future 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue overpass. For safety reasons, this work requires full-lane closures between the hours of 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. and motorists are strongly encouraged to begin planning alternate routes.

The schedule for closures on US 41 between 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue and WIS 44 include:

#### **Monday, March 29**

- US 41 southbound lanes closed with through freeway traffic detoured to Koeller Street
- US 41 northbound passing (left) lane closed

#### **Tuesday, March 30**

- US 41 northbound and southbound lanes closed with through freeway traffic detoured to Koeller Street

#### **Wednesday, March 31**

- US 41 northbound lanes closed with through freeway traffic detoured to Koeller Street
- US 41 southbound passing (left) lanes closed

Law enforcement will monitor traffic on the detour route and portable message signs will be placed prior to construction to inform motorists. The 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue overpass is being replaced as part of the US 41 Project in Winnebago County and is valued at approximately \$2.2 million.
