Meeting purpose

The purpose of these meetings is to provide businesses and residents with up-to-date information on:

- 2014 construction activities and schedules
- Planned noise barriers along the US 41 mainline
- Temporary signage opportunities for businesses during construction

Meeting format

Today's business group meeting will be from 7:30 to 9 a.m. with a brief presentation at 7:45 a.m. The public involvement meeting will be from 4:30 to 6 p.m. with a brief presentation at 4:45 p.m. Please review the project displays, and feel free to speak with project staff with any questions or concerns. A form is available for written comments that can be turned in at the meeting or mailed to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT).

Noise Barriers

At the start of the US 41 Project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation determined noise impacts and evaluated possible mitigation measures, such as noise barriers. After careful evaluation, WisDOT is planning to install noise barriers to minimize noise impacts along portions of the US 41 mainline.

Noise barriers will be constructed along segments of US 41 between the WIS 172 and Mason Street interchanges as shown on the map to the right.



Planned noise barriers along US 41 mainline

NOISE BARRIER CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE (Tentative)

- 2014** - Begin noise barrier construction in limited areas
- 2015** - Construct most of the noise barriers along US 41
- 2016** - Complete any remaining noise barrier construction



US 41 Project traffic impacts: 2014

(schedule subject to change)

CORMIER RD

March 2014 - Summer 2015

2014 - During US 41 bridge reconstruction, Cormier Rd will have:

- Lane restrictions and intermittent nighttime lane CLOSURES
- A 30-day CLOSURE outside of the school year (tentative and would not be concurrent with Morris Ave CLOSURE)

MORRIS AVE

March 2014 - Summer 2015

2014 - During US 41 bridge reconstruction, Morris Ave will have:

- Lane restrictions and intermittent nighttime lane closures
- A 30-day CLOSURE outside of the school year (tentative and would not be concurrent with Cormier Rd CLOSURE)

HANSEN RD BRIDGE

September 2013 - Summer 2014

Reconstructed bridge will reopen in summer 2014

WIS 172 RAMPS

Fall 2013 - Summer 2016

2014 - Ramp closures include:

- The eastbound WIS 172 to northbound US 41 ramp will remain CLOSED through summer 2014
- The ramp from northbound US 41 to westbound WIS 172 will have a 14-day CLOSURE
- All other ramps will have intermittent nighttime CLOSURES

PARKVIEW RD

August 2013 - Summer 2016

2014 - During US 41 bridge reconstruction, Parkview Rd will:


- Have reduced lane and shoulder widths
- Be CLOSED for 45 days in fall 2014

ONEIDA ST/WAUBE LN INTERCHANGE

September 2013 - Summer 2016

2014 - Construction continues; Interchange and Oneida St will:

- Remain open during construction
- Have intermittent nighttime lane and ramp CLOSURES



Future opportunities for construction update meetings

WisDOT will continue to hold construction update meetings throughout the project's duration to keep businesses and the public informed. Future meetings will be held at key milestones and every spring until construction is complete.
