Meeting purpose


The primary purpose of these meetings is to provide to the business community, local officials and general public firsthand information about construction activities scheduled for the I-43 interchange area. These meetings will provide updates on:

- 2013 and 2014 construction activities
- Ramp closures and alternate route options

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will share information about upcoming construction in the I-43 interchange area, along with information about alternate routes and temporary signing opportunities that will connect customers with area businesses during construction.

Meeting format

Today's business group meeting will be from 7:30 to 9 a.m. with a brief presentation at 7:45 a.m. The public information meeting will be from 4:30 to 6 p.m. with a brief presentation at 4:45 p.m. Please review the project displays, and feel free to speak with project staff about questions or concerns. 
I-43 interchange reconstruction


In September 2013, early bridge and grading work will begin in advance of the reconstruction of the I-43 interchange. This initial work is the first step in the complete reconstruction of the I-43 system interchange. Key design features for the interchange include:

- Reconstructing the interchange with directional ramps (all loop ramps eliminated)
- Constructing new bridges over Wietor Drive, Canadian National railroad, I-43 and Duck Creek
- Eliminating existing access between Velp Avenue and I-43 via US 41. Atkinson Drive will be used to access southbound I-43 from Velp Avenue or to access Velp Avenue from northbound I-43

Construction timelines

- 1** Lineville Road interchange
Summer 2013 – spring 2015
- 2** US 41 mainline reconstruction (Duck Creek to Lineville Road)
Summer 2013 – spring 2015
- 3** I-43 interchange
Fall 2013 – spring 2017
- 4** Velp Avenue interchange
March 2015 – spring 2017
- 5** Beaver Dam Creek box culvert, creek realignment, Velp Avenue stormwater pond, Island Court/Lone Grove cul-de-sacs
Spring 2013 – spring 2014
- 6** US 41 mainline reconstruction (Memorial Drive to Duck Creek)
March 2015 – spring 2017

Alternate routes during I-43 interchange construction (November 2013 to May 2014)

Construction at the I-43 interchange is beginning this fall. The work will require a weekend closure of the northbound US 41 on-ramp from Velp Avenue in fall 2013 and 30-day closures of the following ramps in spring 2014 :

- Northbound I-43 to southbound US 41 loop ramp
- Northbound US 41 to southbound I-43 loop ramp
- Southbound US 41 off-ramp at Velp Avenue
- Northbound US 41 on-ramp from Velp Avenue

The exact dates of the closures will be determined later this fall following additional coordination with the contractor. Nighttime and intermittent freeway, ramp and lane closures will also be required. WisDOT will perform additional business and public outreach prior to closures.

Meetings about Velp Avenue and I-43 construction

Later this fall, WisDOT will hold additional meetings with business owners and operators and the public to share information about year 2015-17 construction staging and traffic impacts at the Velp Avenue and I-43 interchanges.
