Lane closures on US 41 at Lake Butte des Morts and north of Snell Road *Winnebago County traffic impacts for the week of July 5*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region Office in Green Bay is announcing lane restrictions for the week of July 5 on US 41 in the Oshkosh area. Motorists can expect closures in northbound lanes between Snell Road and Breezewood Lane, and on the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway. All lane closures take place during overnight hours.

Tuesday, July 6 through Friday, July 9:

- Various lanes of US 41 northbound between Snell Road and Breezewood Lane closed Tuesday through Thursday from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., and Friday from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. The project involves widening the existing northbound lanes. Speed limits in the area reduced to 55 miles per hour.

Wednesday, July 7:

- Various lanes of US 41 northbound between WIS 21 and US 45 closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for maintenance. During the work, the US 41 northbound on ramp from WIS 21 closed to traffic.

All closures are weather dependant and subject to change. Motorists should use caution and remain alert when driving in this or any work zone.
