Speed limit going up on US 41 in southern Brown County

Northbound joins southbound US 41 at 65 mph

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing the speed limit on northbound US 41 will permanently return to a 65 mph between an area near Orange Lane to just south of Grant Street in Brown County by Wednesday, September 11. It had been 55 mph due to US 41 Project construction. Southbound US 41 in this area went back up to 65 mph on Aug. 20. Crews have been working on this stretch of highway since spring of 2012.

All lane restrictions and work operations are subject to change.
