WisDOT tentatively planning to open US 41 northbound in Brown County by 10 p.m. Sunday

Work completed to continue installation of sanitary sewer under US 41

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) northeast region office in Green Bay is announcing the department is tentatively planning to reopen all northbound lanes of US 41 between WIS 29 (Shawano Ave.) and WIS 54 (Velp Ave.) by 10 p.m. tonight, Sunday, March 24. These lanes had been scheduled to reopen by 5 a.m. Monday. WisDOT reopened the southbound lane in this location at approximately 1:30 p.m. today. The work causing this closure is finished enabling the work for the installation of a sanitary sewer under US 41 between Shawano Ave. and Velp Ave. to continue.

The US 41 northbound lanes were closed on Friday night at 8 p.m. On Saturday afternoon, WisDOT also closed one southbound lane of US 41 in this location to increase safety for both motorists and construction workers.

WisDOT finished its work, removed the boring equipment from beneath the northbound lanes and began backfilling the excavation by about 5 a.m. this morning. When the backfilling, grading and paving of this section is completed, the road will reopen. The department is now able to complete the installation of the sanitary sewer this coming week.

The department wants to recognize its partner in this project, NEW Water and NEW Water's contractor, PTS Contractors, Inc. for their work in resolving this situation successfully.

WisDOT would also like to thank residents and businesses adjacent to the work area and motorists using US 41 over the weekend for their cooperation and patience.
