Speed limit changing on US 41 in Winnebago County

Increase possible due to removal of temporary barrier

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing the speed limit on southbound US 41 will permanently return to a 65 mph speed limit from WIS 114 to US 45 in Winnebago County by Wednesday, December 19. It had been 55 mph. Please note: US 41 between Witzel Avenue and US 45 in Winnebago County remains 55 mph in both directions. Additionally, no speed limit will officially change until the speed limit signs are posted.

The increase is possible due to the removal of temporary concrete barriers along this stretch of US 41. Following a similar removal, the speed limit on northbound US 41 from US 45 to Breezewood Lane returned to 65 mph in early November.

This work is part of a \$45 million project to reconstruct and expand eight miles of US 41 between US 45 and Breezewood Lane. Construction on this segment of US 41 began in March 2011 and is scheduled to be complete by May 2013.

Motorists are reminded to remain alert and use caution when traveling through this or any work zone.

All lane restrictions and work operations are subject to change.
