About the US 41 Project


Construction work on the US 41 Project will span 14 miles in Brown County from 2010-2017, and 17 miles of highway in Winnebago County from 2009-2014.

The project includes:

- traffic lanes expanded from four to six-ten lanes
- reconstruction of 13 interchanges
- improvements to 16 interchanges
- 44 roundabouts
- 17 traffic cameras installed
- widening the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway to eight lanes, plus a bike/pedestrian trail with fishing access

At the **Ninth Avenue** Interchange in Winnebago County, WisDOT will:

- Reconstruct the interchange to a tight diamond configuration with multi-lane roundabout on Ninth Avenue and at ramp ends.
- Build multi-lane roundabouts at South Koeller Street and Ninth Avenue and South Washburn Street and Ninth Avenue.
- Reconstruct the Ninth Avenue bridge over US 41.
- Slightly relocate the east frontage road (Koeller Street) to accommodate the new northbound on-ramp.
- Lengthen on-ramps.

- 1 Ninth Avenue Interchange closed

March 2011

- 2 Roundabout construction at South Koeller Street and Ninth Avenue and South Washburn Street and Ninth Avenue
North/south local access is available at the 9th Avenue intersections of Washburn Street and Koeller Street.

July 2011

- 3 Overpass, northbound exit and entrance ramps reopen

November 2011

- 4 Southbound exit and entrance ramps reopen
