

Lake Butte des Morts Causeway Reconstruction

Schedule:

August 2009 through
July 2013

Location:

Work will span US 41 from the
US 45 interchange to the WIS 21
interchange.

About the US 41 Project:

Construction work on the US 41
Project will span over 17 miles of
highway in Winnebago County from
2009-2014, and 14 miles in Brown
County from 2010-2017.

The project includes:

- traffic lanes expanded from four to six or more lanes depending on the location
- reconstruction of 13 interchanges
- improvements to 16 interchanges
- 40 roundabouts
- 17 traffic cameras installed
- widening the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway to eight lanes, plus a bike/pedestrian trail with fishing access

Construction began in September 2011 on new bridge structures. Crews will continue placing new pavement with eight lanes—four lanes in each direction.

Traffic impacts:

- Two lanes of traffic will remain open in both directions, but lanes and shoulders will be narrow; motorists may experience temporary nighttime closures as trucks and equipment move in and out of the work zone; the speed limit will be reduced to 55 mph.
- All lanes of traffic are scheduled to be open in late July 2013. The bike-pedestrian trail is scheduled for completion in November, 2013.
