About the I-41 Project:

Construction work on the I-41 Project will span over 14 miles in Brown County from 2010-2017, and 17 miles of highway in Winnebago County from 2009-2014.

The project includes:

- traffic lanes expanded from four to six-ten lanes
- reconstruction of 13 interchanges
- improvements to 16 interchanges
- 40 roundabouts
- 17 traffic cameras installed
- widening the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway to eight lanes, plus a bike/pedestrian trail with fishing access

Reconstruction of part of the I-41 Mainline in Brown County continues in 2015. The sections under construction

include: **Memorial Drive to Lakeview Drive** and **Glory Road to 9th Street**.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS



I-41 mainline reconstruction

Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in both directions throughout the project, although the lanes will be constricted and the speed limit will be reduced to 55 mph. Periodic nighttime lane closures may occur between the hours of 7 p.m. and 5 a.m.
