

## Lineville Road (County M) Interchange

### Schedule:

June 2013 through May 2015

### Location:

Lineville Road (County M) and US 41  
Brown County

### About the US 41 Project:


Construction work on the US 41 Project will span over 14 miles in Brown County from 2010-2017, and 17 miles of highway in Winnebago County from 2009-2014.

The project includes:

- traffic lanes expanded from four to six or more lanes depending on the location
- reconstruction of 13 interchanges
- improvements to 16 interchanges
- 40 roundabouts
- 17 traffic cameras installed
- widening the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway to eight lanes, plus a bike/pedestrian trail with fishing access


The interchange at **Lineville Road (County M)** in Brown County will be reconstructed to improve safety, increase capacity and improve traffic operations. The bridge will also be raised to provide greater vertical clearance over **US 41**. The entrance ramps will be rebuilt, and the exit ramps will be reconstructed as two-lane ramps. In addition, **US 41** will be expanded to six lanes, plus auxiliary lanes, from approximately **Lineville Road** to the south.

The **Lineville Road** work will include:

- Constructing roundabouts at the northbound and southbound ramp terminals, and at the intersections of **Lineville Road** with **East Deerfield Avenue** and **West Deerfield Avenue**.
- Expanding **Lineville Road** to four lanes through interchange area.
- Constructing a free-flow right-turn lane for eastbound traffic at the **US 41** southbound entrance ramp terminal.

# TRAFFIC IMPACTS



## Lineville Road interchange

August - October 2014

- 1** The interchange, including access across US 41 and the intersections of east and west Deerfield Avenue, is CLOSED for 60 days, weather permitting (effective August 18, 2014).
- 2** Access to East Deerfield Avenue and Parkfield Court will be maintained through the use of a temporary access road.
