

## US 41 and I-43 Interchange

### About the US 41 Project:


Construction work on the US 41 Project will span over 14 miles in Brown County from 2010-2017, and 17 miles of highway in Winnebago County from 2009-2014.

The project includes:

- Expanding traffic lanes from four to six or more lanes depending on the location
- Reconstruction of 13 interchanges
- Improvements to 16 interchanges
- 40 roundabouts
- 17 traffic cameras installed
- Widening the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway to eight lanes, plus a bike/pedestrian trail with fishing access

The following are some key design features for the **I-43** interchange for improved long-term safety and operations:

- Reconstruct the interchange with directional ramps (all loop ramps eliminated).
- Construct new bridges, with additional lanes and widened shoulders over **CN Railroad, Wietor Drive, I-43, and Duck Creek.**

- **Velp Avenue** access to and from **I-43** will be attained at adjacent interchanges, including the **Atkinson Drive** interchange.

Intermittent ramp closures and lane restrictions and full ramp closures will occur in spring/summer 2014.

# TRAFFIC IMPACTS



## I-43 Interchange

- 1** March - September 2015  
**Northbound US 41 to southbound I-43** will CLOSE.
- 2** July - November 2015  
On-ramp from **Velp Avenue to northbound US 41** will CLOSE.
- 3** October 2015 - October 2016  
Exit ramp from **southbound US 41 to Velp Avenue** will CLOSE.
- 4** October 2015 - September 2016  
**Southbound US 41 to southbound I-43** will CLOSE.
- 5** October 2015 - September 2016  
**Northbound I-43 to southbound US 41** will CLOSE.
