About the US 41 Project:


Construction work on the US 41 Project will span over 14 miles in Brown County from 2010-2017, and 17 miles of highway in Winnebago County from 2009-2014.

The project includes:

- traffic lanes expanded from four to six or more lanes depending on the location
- reconstruction of 13 interchanges
- improvements to 16 interchanges
- 40 roundabouts
- 17 traffic cameras installed
- widening the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway to eight lanes, plus a bike/pedestrian trail with fishing access




At the **Velp Avenue (US 141)** interchange in Brown County, WisDOT will:

- Reconstruct **Velp Avenue** under **US 41** to include bicycle and pedestrian accommodations.
- Construct new bridges over **Velp Avenue**.
- Install roundabouts at the ramp terminals and at the intersection of **Velp Avenue** and **Memorial Drive**.
- Lengthen on-ramps for future ramp metering.
- Replace the existing Beaver Dam Creek box culvert under **US 41** just south of **Velp Avenue** (March through November 2013). The box culvert will be lengthened to accommodate additional traffic lanes and wider shoulders.
- Install law enforcement pads on the on-ramps.
- Install crash investigation sites on the exit ramps.
- Construct a storm water detention pond.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS



Velp Avenue (US 141) Interchange

Fall 2013

- 1 Eastbound **Velp Avenue** will close for up to 21 days.

Northbound on-ramp from **Velp Avenue** will close for one weekend (Friday through Monday) this fall -- exact dates to be announced.

Spring 2014

- 2 Southbound **US 41** to **Velp Avenue** ramp will close for 30 consecutive days.

Northbound on-ramp from **Velp Avenue** will close for 30 consecutive days.

2015 - 2017

Watch for further updates to traffic impacts throughout the reconstruction of the **Velp Avenue** interchange.
