September 2013 through Fall 2015

Location:

Brown County

About the US 41 Project:

Construction work on the US 41 Project will span over 14 miles in Brown County from 2010-2017, and 17 miles of highway in Winnebago County from 2009-2014.

The project includes:

- traffic lanes expanded from four to six or more lanes depending on the location
- reconstruction of 13 interchanges
- improvements to 16 interchanges
- 40 roundabouts
- 17 traffic cameras installed
- widening the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway to eight lanes, plus a bike/pedestrian trail with fishing access

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Project Construction Timeline Sept 2013 through Fall 2015


The **Interchange at Oneida Street/Waube Lane Interchange (County AAA)** in Brown County will be reconstructed to improve safety, increase capacity, and improve traffic operations.

The project will include:

- Reconstruction of ramp terminal intersections.
- Lengthening the southbound on-ramp.
- Installing crash investigation sites on the exit ramps.
- Installing bicycle and pedestrian accommodations along **Waube Lane/Oneida Street** from **Allied Street** to **Ramada Way**.
- Construction of a storm water detention pond in the southeast quadrant.

Waube Lane/ Oneida Street (County AAA) interchange

September 2013
through April 2015

- 1** Interchange and **Oneida Street** will remain open during construction
Intermittent nighttime lane and ramp closures will occur.

April through August
2015

Oneida Street to have Bi-directional traffic, with 1 lane in the westbound direction and 2 lanes in the eastbound direction.
