WIS 172 Ramps

Schedule:

August 2013 through fall 2016

Location:

Brown County

About the I-41 Project:

Construction work on the I-41 Project will span over 14 miles in Brown County from 2010-2017, and 17 miles of highway in Winnebago County from 2009-2014.

The project includes:

- Traffic lanes expanded from four to six or more lanes depending on the location.
- Reconstruction of 13 interchanges.
- Improvements to 16 interchanges.
- 40 roundabouts.
- 17 traffic cameras installed.
- Widening the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway to eight lanes, plus a bike/pedestrian trail with fishing access.

WIS 172 Ramps

Project Construction Timeline: August 2013 through fall 2016

As part of the I-41 Project, WisDOT will improve and reconstruct portions of the **WIS 172** ramps including improvements to shoulders, beam guard, signing, pavement marking and curb and gutter at the interchange. All ramp modifications are needed to properly tie into the expanded mainline **I-41** and the new collector-distributor lanes. The ramps are also being expanded for greater capacity. The improvements to the westbound **WIS 172** ramps are being made to address operational and safety concerns.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS



WIS 172 Ramps

- 1** Southbound **I-41** to westbound **WIS 172** ramp will CLOSE for 14 days in 2016 (COMPLETED).
- 2** Eastbound **WIS 172** to southbound **I-41** ramp will CLOSE for approximately 30 days in 2016 (COMPLETED).
- 3** Eastbound **WIS 172** to northbound **I-41** ramp will CLOSE for approximately 21 days in 2016.
