Public meeting scheduled for US 41 and I-43 interchange work in Brown County

Construction of system-to-system interchange starts later this year

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) NE Region office in Green Bay is announcing a public meeting has been scheduled to provide an update for construction on the US 41 and I-43 interchange. The public information meeting will be held 4:30 to 6 p.m., Monday, Sept. 16, 2013 at WisDOT's US 41 Brown County project office, 1940 W. Mason St., Green Bay. A short presentation is scheduled for 4:45 p.m.

Later this year, construction will begin on the system-to-system interchange project. Construction is expected to last from 2013 to 2017. The public meeting will focus on construction activities in 2013 and 2014.

This meeting will provide information on:

- Status of US 41 and I-43 interchange
- 2013-14 construction activities
- Ramp closures and alternate route options for 2013-14

The public is encouraged to attend the meeting, ask questions and offer comments. The meeting will be held in an open house format and project staff will be available to discuss the projects on an individual basis. Additional public meetings will be held to share information about year 2015-17 construction staging and traffic impacts at Velp Avenue and I-43 interchanges.
