



Velp Ave Interchange



Construction

- Spring 2015 – winter 2016/17
- CLOED for 60 consecutive days in 2016


Completed interchange:

- Maintain full access to and from I-41
- No access between Velp Ave and I-43 via I-41

I-43 Interchange

Construction:

- Fall 2013 – spring 2017
- Provide directional ramps for all movements
- Eliminate loop ramps




Construction Staging

- 2015 construction
 - Northbound US 41
 - Outside lanes of I-43
- 2016 construction
 - Southbound I-41
 - Inside lanes of I-43
 - Velp Avenue (including interchange CLOSURE)
- Long term ramp closures required
 - New and old ramp configurations

 Proximity of the interchanges

Velp Avenue Interchange

- Restrictions in 2015 and 2016
 - Periodic daytime and nighttime lane closures
 - Intermittent full nighttime closures





CLOSED between October 2015 and September 2016


NB I-43 to SB I-41






Full CLOSURE of Velp Avenue to occur in 2016 (60 consecutive days)








