Public meeting to discuss US 41 project in Brown County

Conversation to focus on Scheuring Road interchange construction schedule

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is holding a public information meeting on construction staging and scheduling for the Scheuring Road interchange project in Brown County. The open house meeting is from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, July 13, 2010 at Hemlock Creek Elementary School, 1900 Williams Grant Drive, DePere. There will be a brief presentation at 5:15 p.m.

The reconstructed Scheuring Road interchange incorporates several features to enhance safety and traffic flow. Improvements include:

- Reconstruct the Scheuring Road interchange
- Construct roundabouts along Scheuring Road at the US 41 ramps, PDQ Drive/Mid Valley Drive, and Lawrence Drive
- Remove the Scheuring Road/Mid Valley Drive (north) intersection
- Realign the Mid Valley Drive (north)/Eisenhower Drive intersection
- Incorporate bicycle and pedestrian accommodations

The Scheuring Road interchange will be constructed in stages to enhance safety and minimize travel delay. Construction begins in August 2010. The Scheuring Road interchange is scheduled to be completely closed beginning March 2011 and reopening in October 2011. During complete closure, the public is encouraged to use Freedom Road or Main Avenue as alternative routes.
