Reminder: Full-lane closures on US 41 in Winnebago County

Demolition begins on 20th Avenue overpass in Oshkosh

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is reminding motorists that all lanes of US 41 between 9th Avenue and WIS 44 in Oshkosh will be closed tonight as demolition of the 20th Avenue bridge over US 41 gets underway. The overpass is being removed over the course of the next three nights, between the hours of 9 p.m. - 5 a.m.

For safety reasons the demolition requires full-freeway closures and motorists are strongly encouraged to begin planning alternate routes. During demolition through freeway traffic will be detoured to Koeller Street. Extra law enforcement will be in place to monitor the detour route. Motorists are encouraged to use either WIS 21, 9th Avenue, or WIS 44 to cross US 41.
