About the US 41 Project:


Construction work on the US 41
Project will span over 14 miles in
Brown County from 2010-2017, and
17 miles of highway in Winnebago
County from 2009-2014.

The project includes:

- traffic lanes expanded from four to six-ten lanes
- reconstruction of 13 interchanges
- improvements to 16 interchanges
- 44 roundabouts
- 17 traffic cameras installed
- widening the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway to eight lanes, and include a bike/pedestrian trail with fishing access




At the **Scheuring Road** interchange in Brown County, WisDOT will:

- Reconstruct the **Scheuring Road** bridge over **US 41** and include bicycle and pedestrian accommodations
- Reconstruct exit ramp bridges over Ashwaubenon Creek
- Install four roundabouts along **Scheuring Road** at the ramp terminals and at the intersections of **Lawrence Drive** and **PDQ Drive**
- Lengthen on-ramps
- Install law enforcement pads on the on-ramps
- Install crash investigation sites on the exit ramps
- Remove the intersection of **Scheuring Road** and **Mid Valley Drive** (north)
- Realign **Mid Valley Drive** to connect with **Eisenhower Drive**

1 Scheuring Road interchange closed

Use Freedom Road
(County S) and Main Avenue
(County G) interchanges as
alternate routes. Ramps
open in mid-July.

Mid-July through
mid-September 2011

2 Mid Valley Drive (north) and Eisenhower Road intersection closed

Use Grant Street (County EE)
to the north as an alternate
route.
