Traffic impacts on US 41 at WIS 76, Lake Butte des Morts & 20th Ave.
Winnebago County closures for the week of June 1

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region Office in Green Bay is announcing lane restrictions for the week of June 1 on US 41 in Oshkosh. Motorists can expect closures in northbound and southbound lanes near the WIS 76 interchange and 20th Avenue overpass. Lane restrictions are also anticipated in the southbound lanes over the Lake Butte des Morts Causeway. All lane closures will take place during overnight hours.

Tuesday, June 1 through Thursday, June 3:

- Right lanes of US 41 northbound and southbound near the WIS 76 interchange closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for the reconstruction of the ramps connecting US 41 to WIS 76. Speed limits in the area reduced to 55 miles per hour

Tuesday, June 2 through Wednesday, June 3:

- Right lane of US 41 southbound between US 45 and WIS 21 closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to allow for girder placement at the future Lake Butte des Morts overpass. Rolling roadblocks scheduled throughout the night stopping traffic for up to 20 minutes each time.

Wednesday, June 3:

- Various lanes of US 41 northbound and southbound between WIS 44 and 9th Avenue near the reconstructed 20th Avenue overpass closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to remove concrete traffic barrier.

All closures are weather dependant and subject to change. Motorists should to use caution and remain alert when driving through this or any work zone.
