US 41 Project roundabout seminar at Oshkosh West High School

July 24 event is free and open to the public

(Green Bay) A meeting aimed at educating motorists about roundabouts is scheduled for Saturday, July 24 from 9 a.m. to noon at Oshkosh West High School, 375 N. Eagle St., Oshkosh. The seminar is all about roundabouts: what they are, why they are being built as part of the US 41 Project and what motorists need to know about navigating them. It will be an open house-style meeting, so anyone can stop in at any time from 9 a.m. until noon. Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) staff will give brief 15-minute presentations on each half hour followed by question and answer sessions.

The class will be held in room "F" at Oshkosh West High School. Park in the main parking lot and enter door #24.

Roundabouts are relatively new to Wisconsin and 16 of them are being constructed in Winnebago County as part of the US 41 Project. While they are easy to navigate, there is a learning curve for motorists who are new to them. This meeting is just part of an overall outreach campaign by WisDOT to educate motorists about roundabouts.
