US 41 Project roundabout seminar at West De Pere High School

July 31 event is free and open to the public

(Green Bay) A meeting to provide information about roundabouts will be held Sat., July 31, from 9 a.m. to noon at West De Pere High School, 665 Grant St, De Pere. The seminar will be all about roundabouts: what they are, why they are being built as part of the US 41 Project and what motorists need to know about navigating through them. It will be an "Open House" style meeting, so anyone can drop in at any time from 9 a.m. until noon. Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) staff will give brief 15-minute presentations on each half hour, and will then be available to answer questions. The seminars will be held in West De Pere High School's Commons and Auditorium. Use the Auditorium-Field House entrance (Door #2) from the parking lot.

Roundabouts are relatively new to Wisconsin, and up to 28 of them are being built in Brown County as part of the US 41 Project. While they are easy to navigate, there is a learning curve for motorists who are new to them. This meeting is just part of an overall outreach campaign by WisDOT to educate motorists about roundabouts.
