US 41 traffic impacts in Winnebago County for the week of June 14

Lane closures planned at WIS 76, Snell Road, Witzel Avenue, and 20th Avenue

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is announcing lane restrictions planned for the week of June 14 on US 41 in the Oshkosh area. Motorists can expect closures in northbound and southbound lanes near the WIS 76 interchange, Snell Road, Witzel Avenue and 20th Avenue. All lane closures take place during overnight hours.

Monday, June 14 through Thursday, June 17:

- Right lanes of US 41 northbound and southbound near the WIS 76 interchange closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for the reconstruction of the ramps connecting US 41 to WIS 76. Speed limits in the area have been reduced to 55 miles per hour.

Monday, June 14:

- Various lanes of US 41 northbound and southbound near the new Snell Road overpass closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. so construction crews can stain overpass.

Monday, June 14:

- Left lane of US 41 southbound between WIS 21 and 9th Avenue closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to allow for girder placement at the reconstructed Witzel Avenue overpass. Rolling roadblocks scheduled throughout the night stopping traffic for up to 20 minutes.

Tuesday, June 15:

- Left lane of US northbound between 9th Avenue and WIS 21 closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to allow for girder placement at the reconstructed Witzel Avenue overpass. Rolling roadblocks scheduled throughout the night stopping traffic for up to 20 minutes.

Monday, June 14 through Thursday, June 17:

- Various lanes of US 41 northbound and southbound between 9th Avenue and WIS 44 closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. so construction crews can stain the reconstructed 20th Avenue overpass.

All closures are weather dependant and subject to change. Motorists must remain alert when driving through any work zone.
