Reminder: Closure tonight for Memorial Drive under US 41 in Brown County
Bridge demolition scheduled overnight Tuesday

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing full overnight closures for eastbound and westbound Memorial Drive between Village Court and Vincent Road under US 41 in the village of Howard, Brown County 6 p.m. tonight, Sept. 10 to 7 a.m. tomorrow, Sept. 11 for bridge demolition.

Drivers are advised to seek alternative routes during these times.

All lane restrictions are weather dependent and subject to change.
