Updated: US 41 Project lane closures for April 7 – April 11

Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing US 41 Project lane restrictions for April 7 – April 11 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Drivers should be aware of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits in both counties and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone. Details of all closures are included below.

Brown County

US 41

Drivers should anticipate various overnight single lane closures on southbound and northbound US 41 along the entire Brown County corridor from south of Glory Road to Lineville Road. Lane closures can vary along the corridor, so drivers are urged to stay alert, pay attention to road signs, slow down and use caution when entering any work zone. The US 41 Project plans to have at least one lane of traffic open at all times on both northbound and southbound US 41 during construction. This does not include closures by local authorities for accidents or unusual incidents (such as weather).

Oneida Street

- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to Oneida Street will be closed **NIGHTLY**, Monday, April 7, through Friday, April 11, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

WIS 172

- Eastbound WIS 172 between southbound and northbound US 41 ramps will have a **FULL overnight closure** on Tuesday, April 6, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. In addition, the southbound off-ramp to eastbound WIS 172 will be closed from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Both closures will be detoured as follows:

- Traffic seeking WIS 172 will be detoured south to Oneida Street, take Oneida Street east to northbound US 41, and follow US 41 northbound to WIS 172
- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to eastbound WIS 172 will be closed on **overnight** Wednesday, April 9, from 2 to 6 a.m. Detour as follows:
 - Traffic will be detoured off at Ashland Avenue, take Ashland Avenue north to Vanderperren Way, follow Vanderperren Way west to eastbound WIS 172 on-ramp

Cormier Road

- Cormier Road under US 41 will have **FULL overnight closures** on both Wednesday and Thursday, April 9 and 10, from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. for bridge demolition.

Lombardi Avenue/US 41

- **Full closure** of southbound US 41 between the Lombardi interchange on and off-ramps will be closed Tuesday night, April 8, from 10 p.m. until 1 a.m. US 41 southbound traffic will be detoured off and on again at the Lombardi Avenue southbound ramps.
- Southbound US 41 on-ramp from Lombardi Avenue will be closed **NIGHTLY** on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, April 8, 9, 10 and 11, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to Lombardi Avenue will be closed **overnight** Tuesday, April 8 and Friday April 11 from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

WIS 29

- Westbound WIS 29 between southbound and northbound US 41 ramps will have a **FULL overnight closure** on Thursday, April 10, from 9 p.m. to 1 a.m. Detour as follows:
 - Westbound WIS 29 traffic will be detoured north to Velp Avenue, take Velp Avenue west to southbound US 41 and follow US 41 south to westbound WIS 29
- Eastbound WIS 29 between Packerland Drive and Taylor Street will have single lane closures on Thursday, April 10, from 6 p.m. to 1 a.m.

Winnebago County

US 41

County GG and Y overpasses are closed. Northbound and southbound US 41 are reduced from three lanes to two lanes between Snell Road and County G until mid-August.
