MEETING PURPOSE

The primary purpose of these meetings is to provide the business community and general public with firsthand information regarding the construction activities scheduled in the WIS 29 (Shawano Avenue) and Mason Street interchange areas. Along with the construction of the WIS 29 and Mason Street interchanges, this meeting focuses on construction along mainline US 41 from 9th Street to Memorial Drive, mainline WIS 29, County RK, County J, County EB, Taylor Street/Shawano Avenue intersection, and Lambeau Street. This meeting will provide updates on:

- 2011 construction activities (details on page 2)
- Overall construction schedule
- Road closures and alternative access options

WisDOT will present information about the upcoming construction, the impacts to residents, businesses and customers, and present information about business signing that will help customers find businesses during construction.


CONSTRUCTION STARTS THIS SPRING IN THE WIS 29 AND MASON STREET INTERCHANGE AREAS

Fill / Large Structures:

Substantial construction will also begin on new bridge structures as well as embankment placement beginning in July 2011. The work will be widespread throughout the interchange areas, adjacent to US 41 and WIS 29 and in general won't require closures. See shaded area.





CONSTRUCTION TIMELINES 2011 - 2015

In early May, construction began on the Shawano Avenue and Taylor Street intersection and will continue through November 2011. Later this spring, construction will start on County J and County RK (new frontage road between Packerland Drive and County J). The reconstruction of Lambeau Street will begin in June 2011 and be completed in August 2011. The Mason Street interchange construction will begin early 2012.

Reconstruction of US 41 mainline between 9th Street and Larsen Road is included with the Mason Street interchange project. This segment of US 41 mainline and the Mason Street interchange will be completed by summer 2012. Reconstruction of mainline US 41 from Larsen Road to Memorial Drive and mainline WIS 29 will begin in 2012. The reconstruction of the WIS 29 interchange is scheduled to begin in spring 2013. All major construction activities in the WIS 29 and Mason Street interchange areas will be completed by 2015.

FUTURE OPPORTUNITIES FOR BUSINESS GROUP MEETINGS AND CONSTRUCTION UPDATE MEETINGS

WisDOT will continue to hold business group meetings throughout the project's duration to keep businesses informed. Future business meetings will be held at the following key milestones:

- Preconstruction meeting (winter 2011 - Mason Street interchange and US 41 mainline (9th Street to Larsen Road))
- Annual construction update meetings (every spring until construction is finished)

Once the project starts, construction updates and meetings will be held for businesses by the Project Construction Leader (PCL) on a regular basis for the duration of the project.

Highway Business Signs

Businesses should form associations or committees to coordinate development and identify proposed locations of signs about 6-12 months ahead of construction. Approximately one month ahead of construction, businesses should complete and submit a business sign permit application and arrange for sign placement.
