Weather reschedules closures at WIS 76 and Lake Butte des Morts

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is announcing additional lane restrictions for the week of June 7 on US 41 in the Oshkosh area due to weather conditions. Motorists should expect two additional days of closures in northbound and southbound lanes near the WIS 76 interchange and one extra day near the future Lake Butte des Morts Drive overpass. All lane closures will take place during overnight hours.

Wednesday, June 9 through Thursday, June 10:

- Right lanes of US 41 northbound and southbound near the WIS 76 interchange closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for the reconstruction of the ramps connecting US 41 to WIS 76. Speed limits in the area reduced to 55 miles per hour.

Wednesday, June 9:

- Right lane of US 41 northbound and southbound between US 45 and WIS 21 closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to allow for girder placement at the future Lake Butte des Morts Drive overpass. Rolling roadblocks are scheduled that could stop traffic for up to 20 minutes.

All closures are weather dependant and subject to change. Motorists should to use caution and remain alert when driving in this or any work zone.
