### **US 41 Project lane closures for November 18 – November 22**

*Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties*

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing US 41 Project lane restrictions for November 18 – November 22 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Drivers should be aware of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits in both counties and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone. Details of all closures are included below.

**NOTE:** These closures are for the US 41 Project only

**The Leo Frigo Bridge remains closed indefinitely. Please use the WIS 172 bypass or plan an alternate route.**

#### **Brown County**

##### **US 41**

Drivers should anticipate various overnight single lane closures on southbound and northbound US 41 along the entire Brown County corridor from south of Scheuring Road to Lineville Road. Lane closures can vary along the corridor, so drivers are urged to stay alert, pay attention to road signs, slow down and use caution when entering any work zone. The US 41 Project plans to have at least one lane of traffic open at all times on both northbound and southbound US 41 during construction. This does not include closures by local authorities for accidents or unusual incidents (such as weather).

##### **Oneida Street**

Drivers can expect various overnight lane closures on eastbound and westbound Oneida Street under US 41 throughout the week from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. In addition, the following ramp closures will be in place:

- Southbound US 41 off-ramp to Oneida Street will be closed overnight on Monday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to Oneida Street will be closed nightly Monday through Thursday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Northbound US 41 on-ramp from Oneida Street will be closed nightly Tuesday through Thursday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

## **WIS 172**

Throughout the week, eastbound and westbound WIS 172 between Ashland Avenue and Babcock Road will have overnight single lane closures for grading operations. The following ramp will have closures:

- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to WIS 172 will be closed nightly Monday through Thursday from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. for sewer installation. The following detour will be in place:
  - **Northbound US 41** traffic seeking **eastbound** WIS 172 will be detoured off at Ashland Avenue, take Ashland Avenue north to Vanderperren Way, follow Vanderperren Way west to the eastbound WIS 172 entrance ramp
  - **Northbound US 41** traffic seeking **westbound** WIS 172 will take Ashland Avenue north to Pilgrim Way and follow Pilgrim Way to westbound WIS 172

## **Lombardi Avenue**

The following ramp will be closed:

- Northbound US 41 on-ramp from Lombardi Avenue will be closed overnight on Monday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

## **WIS 29**

Drivers can expect various lane closures on eastbound and westbound WIS 29 throughout the week.

The following ramps will also be closed:

- Southbound US 41 off-ramp to WIS 29 will be closed overnight on Tuesday from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Southbound US 41 on-ramp from WIS 29 will be closed overnight on Thursday from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

## **Velp Avenue**

Drivers can anticipate various overnight lane closures on eastbound and westbound Velp Avenue between Island Court and Memorial Drive throughout the week from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

The following ramp will be closed:

- Southbound US 41 on-ramp from Velp Avenue will be closed nightly Monday through Wednesday from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

## **I-43**

The following ramp will be closed:

- Northbound I-43 to northbound US 41 ramp will be closed overnight on Monday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

**All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.**
