US 41 Project lane closures for September 16 – September 20

Traffic restrictions in Brown and Winnebago counties

(Green Bay) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing US 41 Project lane restrictions for September 16 – September 20 in Brown and Winnebago counties. Drivers should be aware of 11-foot wide lanes and reduced speed limits in both counties and remember to use caution while traveling through any work zone. Details of all closures are included below.

Winnebago County

US 41

Drivers can expect lane restrictions on US 41 near the County G overpass construction.

Brown County

US 41

Drivers should anticipate various overnight single lane closures on southbound and northbound US 41 along the entire Brown County corridor from south of Scheuring Road to Lineville Road. Lane closures can vary along the corridor, so drivers are urged to stay alert, pay attention to road signs, slow down and use caution when entering any work zone. The US 41 Project plans to have at least one lane of traffic open at all times on both northbound and southbound US 41 during construction. This does not include shutdowns by local authorities for accidents or unusual incidents (such as weather). In addition, the following ramps will be closed:

Monday, September 16

- Northbound US 41 on and off-ramps at Oneida Street will be closed from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m.
- Southbound and northbound US 41 on-ramps from Lineville Road will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to Lineville Road will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Tuesday, September 17

- Southbound and northbound US 41 on-ramps from Lineville Road will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to Lineville Road will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Wednesday, September 18

- Southbound and northbound US 41 on-ramps from Lineville Road will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Northbound US 41 off-ramp to Lineville Road will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

WIS 172

Throughout the week, westbound WIS 172 between Ashland Avenue and Babcock Road will have single lane closures from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. for grading operations. On Monday, September 16, northbound US 41 off-ramp to WIS 172 will be closed from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Detour as follows:

- **Northbound US 41** traffic seeking WIS 172 will exit at Lombardi Avenue and take the on-ramp to southbound US 41 to WIS 172

Drivers can expect a ramp closure at northbound US 41 off-ramp to westbound WIS 172 on Monday through Thursday from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. The following detour will be in place:

- **Northbound US 41** traffic wanting to take westbound WIS 172 will be detoured to eastbound WIS 172 to the Ashland Avenue exit, take Vanderperren Way west to Holmgren Way, follow Holmgren Way north to Pilgrim Way and take Pilgrim Way east to westbound WIS 172

In addition, the westbound WIS 172 to southbound US 41 ramp will be closed Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.

WIS 29

Drivers can expect various overnight single lane closures on eastbound and westbound WIS 29 from Packerland Drive to Taylor Street throughout the week. Northbound US 41 will be closed on Wednesday, September 18 at WIS 29 from 10 p.m. to 2 a.m. The following detour will be in place:

- **Northbound US 41** traffic will take the off-ramp to WIS 29, cross WIS 29 and re-enter northbound US 41 using the entrance ramp from WIS 29

Drivers can also anticipate ramp closures of the northbound on-ramp from WIS 29 on Monday, September 16 and Tuesday, September 17 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. In addition the ramp will be closed on Thursday, September 19 from 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. The following detour will be in place:

- **WIS 29** traffic seeking northbound US 41 will be detoured east on WIS 29 to Military Avenue, follow Military Avenue north to Velp Avenue and take Velp Avenue west to US 41

Velp Avenue

There will be various overnight single lane closures on eastbound and westbound US 141/Velp Avenue between Island Court and Memorial Drive throughout the week from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. In addition, the northbound US 41 off-ramp to Velp Avenue will be closed on Monday, September 16 from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

I-43

Drivers can expect overnight single lane closures on northbound and southbound I-43 between Atkinson Drive and US 41 from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. On Monday, September 16, there will be a full closure of the northbound I-43 ramp to southbound US 41 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured as follows:

- **Northbound I-43** traffic wanting to take southbound US 41 will be detoured at Atkinson Drive, follow Atkinson Drive south to Velp Avenue and take Velp Avenue west to southbound US 41

The northbound I-43 to northbound US 41 ramp will be closed on Tuesday, September 17 through Thursday, September 19 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. and on Friday, September 20 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured as follows:

- **Northbound I-43** traffic seeking northbound US 41 will take southbound US 41 to Velp Avenue and take the on-ramp from Velp Avenue to northbound US 41

Drivers can also anticipate a full closure of the southbound US 41 to southbound I-43 ramp on Monday and Thursday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. and on Friday from 8 p.m. to noon. Traffic will be detoured as follows:

- **Southbound US 41** traffic seeking southbound I-43 will take Velp Avenue east to Atkinson Drive, follow Atkinson Drive north to southbound I-43

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
